Re: Church & Dwight Co., Inc. Arm & Hammer™ Ammonium Bicarbonate Treated and Untreated Storage Stability

If stored properly, Arm & Hammer Ammonium Bicarbonate (Ammonium Hydrogen Carbonate) Treated or Untreated has a shelf life of 24 months, in which it meets the product specification values without restrictions.

Stored in a cool, dry environment, *treated* Ammonium Bicarbonate is expected to remain relatively free flowing for twelve (12) months, after which it tends to lump and cake. *Untreated* Ammonium Bicarbonate starts to lump and cake within a month after production.

Both treated and untreated Ammonium Bicarbonate can lose a significant amount of weight if stored improperly. Neither the lumping nor the weight loss affects the purity or functionality of the remaining Ammonium Bicarbonate.
